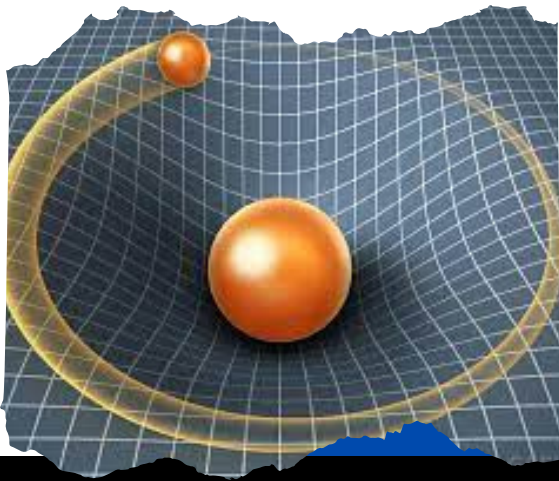


# THE INFINITY OF GOD

## Is time a thing, like space?

Just as God is the creator of the physical universe, God is also the creator of time, so God actually exists outside of time. Since the early 1900s, scientists have understood that space and time are connected. According Einstein's Theory of Relativity, the speed at which something travels and the amount of mass that an object has, will actually impact the rate at which time moves forward—like a penny that moves faster as it gets closer to the inside of a funnel.
