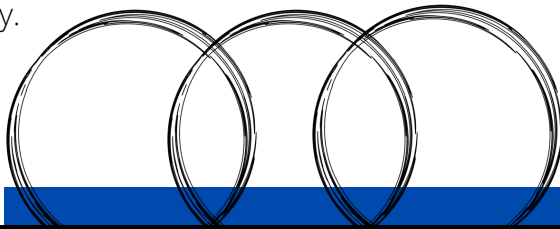


# THE TRINITY

## What is the Trinity?

10:4.2 (112.5) Eternal Deity is perfectly unified; nevertheless there are three perfectly individualized persons of Deity. The Paradise Trinity makes possible the simultaneous expression of all the diversity of the character traits and infinite powers of the First Source and Center and his eternal co-ordinates and of all the divine unity of the universe functions of undivided Deity.

## So...What is it again?

There is only one God, but there are also separate (but perfectly unified) persons within that one God. As a comparison: you have only one brain, but unified with your brain there are different sections that serve different purposes. In the case of the Trinity, the Father is the First Source of all things, including the other two persons of the Trinity. The Son is the Word, meaning that he makes it possible for lower orders of beings (like us) to be personally taught by those who represent God (like Jesus). The Spirit is the Action and is represented by legions of angels who make life in the universe possible.
